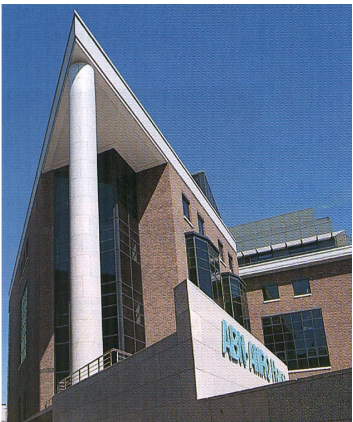


# THE SPEAKER



**Kevin Rudden** is the Company Director responsible for Health & Safety on TGP Projects. He is a Registered Consulting Chartered Engineer and holds a Diploma in Legal Studies. He is an Associate Member of the Institution of Occupational Health & Safety and a Chartered Member of the Institution of Engineers of Ireland.

He has acted as convener of the Association of Consulting Engineers of Ireland/Engineers Ireland Joint Committee on Health & Safety Construction Legislation since 2005, and has been responsible for co-ordinating the activities of these Institutions in relation to Health & Safety..

During 2005/2006 Kevin represented the European Federation of Consulting Engineering Associations (EFCA) at the European Construction Safety Forum, which met in Brussels on a monthly basis. This forum was set up following the Bilboa Declaration in 2004 to ensure greater co-operation between the stakeholders in the European Construction Industry. As part of the work of this group he drafted, with the Architects Council of Europe, "European Designing for Safety in Construction Manual", which advises all professional designers how to comply with the requirements of the European Directive EC92/57.

Kevin has lectured extensively on various Health & Safety issues. On 20<sup>th</sup> September 2006 Kevin presented a paper entitled "Designing for Safety in Construction" at the Construction Safety & Health in Europe conference held in the European Parliament buildings. He also presented a paper entitled "Designing for Safety in Construction" at the Health & Safety Authority Safety Summit in Dublin in May 2006. In March 2007 Kevin presented a paper on the duties of the PSDP under the new Health & Safety Regulations to the ACEI Leadership Course.

Kevin has recently been invited by the European Federation of Consulting Engineers to participate in an advisory committee to assist in the drafting of Guidelines to the Implementation of EC Directive 92/57.

Kevin's experience in relation to Health & Safety in both Ireland and Europe clearly identifies him as one of the most experienced professionals in Construction Health & Safety in the country. He has acted as Project Supervisor Design Stage on numerous projects under the old regulations and is currently involved as Project Supervisor Design Process on a number of projects under the new Health & Safety (Construction) Regulations 2006.

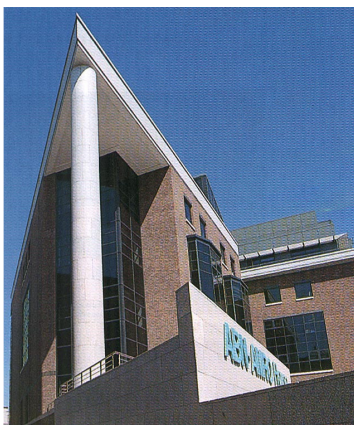
